**JOINT APPLICATION FOR CONSENT TO TRANSFER CONTROL OF
INTERNATIONAL AUTHORITY PURSUANT TO SECTION 214**

Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §214 and Part 63 of the Commission’s Rules, Xiangyang Luo (“Transferor”) and Yonghui Liu (“Transferee”) hereby request consent to the transfer of control of Megatel Netcom Corp. (“Megatel” and collectively with Mr. Luo and Mr. Liu, the “Applicants”) from Mr. Luo to Mr. Liu.

In support of this application, the Applicants respectfully submit the following information:

Description of the Transaction – The Transferor and Transferee have entered into an agreement under which the Transferee will purchase all of the shares of the Transferor in Megatel, which holds an international resale license under FCC File No. ITC-214-20090401-00143. As a result

of the transfer, the Transferee will hold 80% of the outstanding shares of Megatel. Megatel provides international calling card and other services through resale.

Qualification for Streamlined Treatment – The application is eligible for streamlined processing because:

- Neither the Transferee or any of his affiliates is a dominant provider of international telecommunications services,
- Neither the Transferee nor any of his affiliates is affiliated with a foreign carrier and
- None of the Applicants is prohibited from seeking streamline treatment of the application by any of the provisions of Section 63.12(c) of the Commission’s rules.

Public Interest Benefits. Applicants respectfully submit that the proposed transaction will serve the public interest. The Transferor will bring enhanced managerial skills to the business and enable it to continue to serve its customers efficiently and reliably.

(h) Name, address, citizenship and principal business of any person or entity that directly or indirectly owns at least ten percent of the equity of the license holder

Transferee, Yonghui Liu, will hold 80% of the shares of Megatel as a result of the transaction. He is a citizen of China, holding a U.S. green card 098-768-955. He is CEO of Megatel.

The remaining 20% of the shares of Megatel is held by Fay Chen, a citizen of U.S. , who is CFO of Megatel.


- (i) Affiliates with foreign carrier – Transferee is not affiliated with a foreign carrier.
- (j) Certificate regarding foreign carriers – Transferee certifies that he does not control a foreign carrier.
- (k), (l), (m) not applicable
- (n) Special concessions – Transferee certifies that he has not agreed to accept special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier with respect to any U.S. international route where the foreign carrier possesses market power on the foreign end of the route and that he will not enter into such agreements in the future.
- (o) Certification regarding Federal Benefits – The parties hereby certify, pursuant to 47 CFR §§1.2001-1.2003, that to the best of their knowledge, information and belief, no party to the Application is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Durg Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. §583.

CONCLUSION


