**Re: Potential Dismissal of International Section 214 Application for Transfer of Control  
File No. ITC-T/C-20150727-00180

Dear Mr. Castro:

Our records indicate that the application filed by Dasaro USA, LLC (Dasaro) for consent to transfer of control of an international Section 214 authorization, File No. ITC-T/C-20150727-00180, remains pending at the Commission awaiting completion of review by the Executive Branch agencies. On August 6, 2015, we forwarded the application to the Executive Branch agencies. On October 9, 2015, the Commission notified you that, pursuant to Section 63.12(c)(3) of the Commission's rules,<sup>1</sup> your application was removed from streamlined processing pending Executive Branch review and that Dasaro could not commence operations until the authorization is granted.<sup>2</sup>

The Executive Branch agencies have informed us that they have not received a response to supplemental questions sent on November 2, 2015 to your counsel, Mr. Maldonado and due by November 10, 2015. Since that time, the Executive Branch agencies sent your counsel a follow-up email on December 1, 2015 asking for a response by December 4, 2015. The Executive Branch agencies did not receive a response and on December 4, 2015 sent another email asking for a response due by December 10, 2015. The Executive Branch agencies indicate that no response was received. Consequently, the Executive Branch agencies cannot conduct their review of the application and request dismissal of the application.

Please inform us no later than **Monday, January 11, 2016**, if you would like to continue to seek the grant of the transfer of control application. Your response should be submitted in the file – ITC-T/C-20150727-00180 – via IBFS.<sup>3</sup> In addition, please email a copy to me at
