**Re: Post-Transaction Notification of SkyBest Holding Company, LLC
International Bureau File No. ITC-T/C-20180116-00012**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 63.24(e)(4) of the Rules of the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or the “Commission”), 47 C.F.R. § 63.24(e)(4), SkyBest Holding Company, LLC (“SkyBest”) hereby notifies the Commission of the consummation on April 30, 2018, of the transaction effecting the transfer of control of LTC Holding Company, Inc. (“LTC”), including the international Section 214 authorization held by LTC’s wholly-owned subsidiary, Loretto Communication Services, Inc. (“Loretto LD”), to SkyBest.¹

On January 26, 2018, the FCC issued a Public Notice in Report No. TEL-018888S, accepting the application for approval of the transfer of control of the international Section 214 authorization held by Loretto LD to SkyBest. The application was approved by the International Bureau effective February 9, 2018, as reported in Report No. TEL-01892 (DA No. 18-150), issued on February 15, 2018.² The time for reconsideration or FCC review of the approval of the transfer of control expired on March 17, 2018, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.106.

¹ Notice of the consummation of the transfer of control is also being simultaneously provided to the FCC’s Wireline Competition Bureau and Wireless Bureau.

² Public Notice of the domestic Section 214 application for the transfer of control of the authorizations held by LTC’s wholly-owned subsidiaries, Loretto Telephone Company, Inc. (“Loretto Telephone”) and Loretto LD, was issued by the FCC on January 24, 2018, which stated that the transfer of assets could occur on or after February 24, 2018 (WC Docket No. 18-10, DA No. 18-71). On February 26, 2018, the Wireline Competition Bureau granted the application for transfer of control of the domestic Section 214 authorizations in a Public Notice issued in DA 18-181 (WC Docket No. 18-10). The time for reconsideration or FCC review of the approval of the transfer of control expired on March 28, 2018, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.106.


On January 17, 2018, an application for approval of the transfer of control of the wireless license held by Loretto LD under Call Sign WQLH896 (Radio Service Code NN) to SkyBest was filed with the FCC’s Wireless Bureau. The FCC issued a Public Notice on January 24, 2018, in Report No. 12904 accepting the application for filing (File No. 0008058961); however, the Wireless Bureau issued a further Public Notice on February 21, 2018, Report No. 12972, removing the application from the general approval process, effective February 15, 2018. The application

The transaction, as consummated, entailed the purchase by SkyBest of one hundred percent (100%) of the issued and outstanding shares of LTC's common stock. Prior to the purchase, LTC redeemed all of its issued and outstanding shares of Preferred Class A stock and Preferred Class B stock, leaving only its common stock issued and outstanding. As a result of the transaction, LTC and its wholly-owned subsidiaries, Loretto Telephone and Loretto LD, have become direct and indirect wholly-owned subsidiaries of SkyBest, respectively.

The application was consented to March 23, 2018, in a Public Notice issued on March 28, 2018, Report No. 13068. The time period for reconsideration of the Wireless Bureau's action ran on April 27, 2018.
