Notification of Pro Forma Transfer of Control

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is in response to the requests for clarification of Sumita Mukhoty on March 12 regarding the above-referenced Notification of *Pro Forma* Transfer of Control ("Notification").

More specifically, this is to confirm that, after the split-off transaction on December 29, 2017, Liberty Global plc ("Liberty Global") no longer has an ownership interest in Liberty Latin America Ltd. ("Liberty Latin America"), the ultimate parent of the licensees.

As reported in the Notification at 3, n.2, Liberty Latin America was a wholly-owned subsidiary of Liberty Global prior to the split-off transaction. However, Liberty Latin America was not included in the structure charts annexed as Exhibit 1 to the Notification because it was not in the ownership relationships depicted on those charts.
