No other party or entity directly or indirectly holds more than $10 \%$ of the vote or equity of BCM One Group Holdings, Inc. and no other party or entity will hold-directly or indirectly -more than 10\% of the vote and equity of SIP.US LLC (the International Section 214 holder) following close of the transaction. For purposes of clarification, neither James A. Cooper or Robert C. Dunn will hold-directly or indirectly-10\% or more of the equity or vote of SIP.US, the International Section 214 holder, following close of the transaction.
