The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), with the concurrence of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and the U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) (collectively, “the Agencies”), officially withdraws its request to defer action on the above-referenced application to transfer control of U.S. TelePacific Holdings Corp. (TPx Holdings), Arrival Communications, Inc. (Arrival), DSCI, LLC (DSCI), Mpower Communications Corp. (Mpower), TPx Communications Co., and U.S. TelePacific Corp. to Tango Private Holdings II, LLC (Tango) (collectively “the Applicants”). Based on the information provided to the Agencies by the Applicants and analysis by the Agencies of potential national security, law enforcement, and public safety issues, the Agencies hereby recommend to the Commission that the Applicants’ application to transfer control be granted on the condition of the September 2, 2016 Letter of Assurances (LOA).
