Dear Ms. Dortch:

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS), with the concurrence of the Department of Justice (DOJ) (collectively, the USG Parties), hereby notify the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) that the USG Parties have terminated all extant agreements with U.S. TelePacific Holdings Corp. (TelePacific Holdings) and U.S. TelePacific Corp. (TelePacific) upon which control of licenses held by the following entities were conditioned: Arrival Communications, Inc. (Arrival), DSCI, LLC (DSCI), Mpower Communications Corp. (Mpower), TPx Communications Co. (TCC), and NextWeb, Inc. (NextWeb, collectively, the Licensees).

In 2019, TelePacific and TelePacific Holdings submitted a series of applications to transfer FCC licenses held by the Licensees to Tango Private Holdings II, LLC (Tango), a U.S. entity, which resulted in no foreign entity owning more than 10 percent of the Licensees. The FCC granted the applications to transfer control of these licenses from TelePacific and TelePacific Holdings to Tango, conditioned on the September 2, 2016, Commitment Letter which extended the commitments made in a series of agreements dating back to 2005. The USG Parties have now terminated these commitments. Please don't hesitate to contact me with any questions you may have regarding this notification.
