Dear Secretary Dortch:

MTN Infrastructure TopCo, Inc. ("MTN Infrastructure") submits this letter to further supplement the applications filed in the above-captioned proceedings on December 23, 2019. The supplement addresses i) a request by Commission staff regarding information concerning the Applicants' ILEC affiliates and ii) a minor modification regarding the ownership of Transferee.

Information Regarding Applicants' ILEC Affiliates:

North State Telephone Company, ("North State Telephone"), North State's Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier ("ILEC") subsidiary, serves 27,358 ILEC Access Lines in North Carolina as of December 31, 2019.

MTN Infrastructure's subsidiary, Lumos Networks Corporation, through its ILEC subsidiaries, serves 18,291 ILEC Access Lines in Virginia as of June 30, 2019.

SEGRA currently provides competitive service at a number of locations in North State Telephone Company territory.¹ As of today, SEGRA provides service to 53 locations using its

SEGRA has no information whether North State Telephone currently serves customers at any of these locations.

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own last mile facilities. At 47 of these locations SEGRA serves carrier customers; the remaining 6 locations serve enterprise customers. SEGRA serves 48 additional locations in North State Telephone ILEC territory using last mile facilities obtained from third party carriers; 42 of these locations serve carriers; 6 serve enterprise customers. SEGRA faces competition in serving this market as competitive fiber in this territory is available from companies including Charter/Spectrum, AT&T, Windstream, Cogent, Conterra Networks and others.

Supplement Regarding Ownership of Transferee MTN Infrastructure TopCo, Inc.

Subsequent to filing the Application, several individual shareholders of EQT AB, none of whom directly or indirectly hold 10% or more of EQT AB, and thus will not, post-close hold 10% or more of North State Parent, have formed a holding company to hold their shares in EQT AB. This new holding company, Bark Partners, AB, will hold 15.2% of the shares in EQT AB. No person, by virtue of their interest in Bark Partners AB will directly or indirectly hold 10% or greater in MTN Infrastructure or North State after closing the proposed Transaction. The information regarding Bark Partners AB required under the Commission's rules follows.
