Dear Secretary Dortch:

On January 11, 2021, Lingo Communications, LLC ("Transferor"), the Licensees,<sup>1</sup> and B. Riley Principal Investments, LLC ("Transferee") (Transferor, Licensees, and Transferee collectively, "Applicants") filed a Joint Application seeking Commission approval to transfer indirect control of the Licensees to Transferee. The Applicants seek to supplement the Joint Application as set forth herein.

Pursuant to a request from Commission staff, Applicants provide the following additional information regarding the affiliates of Transferee that are discussed in the Joint Application:

- United Online, Inc. is a Delaware corporation. It offers Internet access services to consumers under the NetZero and Juno brands, as well as email, Internet security, web hosting services, and other communications-related services, in the District of Columbia and all 50 states.
- YMax Communications Corp. is a Delaware corporation. It offers competitive local exchange and/or interexchange services in the District of Columbia and all 50 states with the exception of Alaska and New Hampshire.
- magicJack SMB, Inc. is a Florida corporation. It offers interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol services in the District of Columbia and all 50 states with the exception of Alaska.
