### Dear Secretary Dortch:

On February 26, 2021, Hargray Acquisition Holdings, LLC ("Hargray" or "Transferor"), the Licensees, <sup>1</sup> and Cable One, Inc. ("Cable One" or "Transferee") (Hargray, Licensees, and Cable One collectively, the "Applicants") filed a Joint Application seeking Federal Communications Commission ("Commission") approval to transfer indirect control of the Licensees to Transferee. Pursuant to a request from Commission staff, the Applicants seek to supplement the Joint Application with additional information concerning the ownership interests of certain entities that hold an ownership interest in Cable One as explained below.

#### T. Rowe Price Associates, Inc.

The Joint Application stated that T. Rowe Price Associates, Inc. ("T. Rowe") beneficially owned 12.5% of Cable One's outstanding common stock as of December 31, 2020. T. Rowe is a wholly owned subsidiary of T. Rowe Price Group, Inc. ("TROW"). As set forth on the TROW website,<sup>2</sup> the following individuals are on the Board of Directors of TROW:

Neither T. Rowe nor TROW have the power to individually elect or block the election of any officer or director of Cable One, and do not have any control over or involvement in the day-to-day operations or management of the businesses of Cable One and its subsidiaries.

#### BlackRock, Inc.

The Joint Application stated that BlackRock, Inc. ("BlackRock") beneficially owned 10.4% of Cable One's outstanding common stock as of December 31, 2020. As set forth on the BlackRock website,<sup>5</sup> the following individuals are on the Board of Directors of BlackRock:

Information regarding the citizenship of the TROW Board members was not available in a single, consolidated location. With four exceptions, Cable One confirmed the citizenship of each TROW Board member using Securities and Exchange Commission filings made by the other publicly-traded companies in which the Board member is or was involved. Cable One confirmed Ms. Snowe's citizenship via the Biographical Directory of the Unites States Congress. Cable One confirmed Mr. Stevens' citizenship via the Naval Order of the United States website. Cable One confirmed the citizenship of Mr. Bartlett and Mr. Verma through discussions with TROW counsel.

Unless otherwise noted above, each of the members of the BlackRock Board of Directors are U.S. citizens.<sup>12</sup>

Aside from normal-course rights as a beneficial holder of Cable One's common stock, BlackRock does not hold any additional rights to participate in the management or operation of Cable One. BlackRock does not have the power to individually elect or block the election of any officer or director of Cable One, and does not have any control over or involvement in the day-to-day operations or management of the businesses of Cable One and its subsidiaries.

The Joint Application listed certain telecommunications-related entities in which BlackRock held a ten percent (10%) or greater interest as of December 31, 2020 (the "BlackRock Telecom Entities"). Cable One is unable to determine with specificity the domestic telecommunications service providers (other than Cable One's subsidiaries) in which BlackRock may have a ten percent (10%) or greater ownership interest. To develop the list of BlackRock Telecom Entities set forth in the Joint Application, Cable One used third-party software (Ipreo now known as IHS Markit) to analyze the SEC Form 13F filed by BlackRock for the period ending December 31, 2020.

After receiving Commission staff's request for additional information on the BlackRock Telecom Entities, Cable One also reviewed the FCC Forms 602 and/or FCC Forms 175 on file in the Commission's Universal Licensing System ("ULS") that list BlackRock as a disclosable interest holder. As a result of that review, Cable One adds an additional entity – Telephone and Data Systems, Inc. – to the list of BlackRock Telecom Entities set forth in the Joint Application.<sup>13</sup>

As requested by Commission staff, Cable One provides the following information on the services provided by the BlackRock Telecom Entities and the states in which those services are provided:
