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Notice of Pro Forma Transfer of Control

Applicants Gabriel Sanchez ("G. SANCHEZ"), Andres Sanchez ("A. SANCHEZ"), Maria Paulina Merced ("M.P. MERCED"), and James Merced ("MERCED") controlling Members of Licensee Identidad Advertising Development, LLC (herein called the "Applicants,") together with the Licensee and **Infomovil Television & Systems Corp.** ("Transferee") a Florida corporation controlled by the Applicants in equal share to the Licensee hereby give notice of a pro forma transfer of control of ownership of the international authority of Identidad Advertising Development, LLC pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 et. al. (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Federal Communication Commission's (hereafter called "Commission") Rules to provide global or limited international facilities-based and resale services between the United States and international points, except those international point not authorized by the Commission as updated from time to time on the Commission's Exclusion List under a new ownership structure. In support of this application, the Applicants state as follows:

I. INTRODUCTION: Summary of the Pro Forma Transfer

On July 3, 2020, the Commission granted the transfer of control of the Licensee Identidad Advertising Development, LLC. (“Identidad”) from prior owners to the Applicants under File No.: ITC-T/C-20200603-00085. That transaction resulted in an ownership between family members who are the Applicants. The transfer of control was then consummated. The Applicants, then desiring to better structure their holdings and interests in communications, desire to utilize a long-standing holding company under their control to further this function: **Infomovil Television & Systems Corp.**, a Florida corporation owned in pro rata share by Applicants to holdings in the Licensee, FRN: 0005100383. The transfer is simple in nature. Applicant transferors transfer their individual holdings to **Infomovil Television & Systems Corp.** which they own and control in the same interest percentage as the Licensee. Beneficial ownership remains the same as found in File No.: ITC-T/C-20200603-00085 except that Transferee **Infomovil Television & Systems Corp.** is the holding company of their individual interests. The transfer is not substantive under the Commission’s Rules.

The transfer is seamless for consumers and carriers dealing with Identidad, as it will not result in any change in the management of Identidad or discontinue or impair Identidad services.¹ The telecommunications business of the Licensee is resale of international services and it serves no end-user subscribers. Licensee serves carrier customers throughout the United States, but primarily those in the state of Florida. The public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market are unimpaired by this pro forma transfer. Competition will benefit U.S. consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of this Pro Forma Transfer of Identidad Advertising Development’s international Section 214 authority.

¹ Under application File No.: ITC-T/C-20200603-00085 Applicants informed the Commission that their ownership of Identidad Advertising Development may be structured under a holding company. This Notice is made in furtherance of that application statement. Sufficient time has passed since consummation for the Applicants to structure their holdings and operations of the Licensee to make the pro forma transfer seamless in all operational aspects after the July 3, 2020 transfer approval.

II. Request for Streamlined Processing

The Pro Forma transfer is eligible for streamlined processing pursuant to the Commission's Rules, found at 47 C.F.R. § 63.12(a). This Application is eligible for streamlined processing pursuant to Section 63.03(b)(2)(i) because, immediately following the transactions: (1) No applicant or its affiliate(s), as defined in Section 3(1) of the Communications Act (hereafter called "Affiliates") combined shall hold a ten percent (10%) or more share of the interstate and/or interexchange market; and (2) neither the Applicant nor their Affiliates are, or will be, dominant with respect to any service before or after the transaction.²

II. DESCRIPTION OF THE APPLICANTS

A. **Identidad Advertising Development, LLC ("Licensee")**

Identidad Advertising Development, LLC is a Florida Limited Liability Company operating from the State of Florida and provides global facilities based and resold international telecommunications services to the public pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 214 et. al. under Commission Authority File No.: ITC-T/C-20200603-00085.

B. **Company Members (Transferors)**

Sanchez will serve as the CEO of the Transferee with G SANCHEZ serving as a Manager only. G. SANCHEZ is a United States Citizen. G. SANCHEZ is not affiliated with any company holding a dominant position in any international market. Under the contemplated Transaction, G. SANCHEZ's transfer entails the entirety of his membership units in the Licensee to the Transferee. G. SANCHEZ holds 33.34% common voting stock in the Transferee.

2. Andres Sanchez (A. SANCHEZ)

MERCED is not affiliated with any company holding a dominant position in any international market. M.P. MERCED's transfer entails the entirety of her membership units in the Licensee to the Transferee. M.P. MERCED holds 16.66% common voting stock in the Transferee.

4. James Merced (MERCED)

MERCED is natural person, U.S. Citizen and resident of the State of Florida domicile at 848 Brickell Ave, Suite 810 Miami, FL 33131 for purposes of this Application. [*Home address available to Commission upon request. Home address redacted here for purposes of privacy, FOIA and public notice requirements.] MERCED presently holds 16.66% percentage of Licensee's outstanding equity and membership interest. MERCED currently serves as Manager and CFO of the Licensee, and CFO of the Transferee. MERCED is a United States Citizen. MERCED is not affiliated with any company holding a dominant position in any international market. MERCED's transfer entails the entirety of his membership units in the Licensee to the Transferee. MERCED holds 16.66% common voting stock in the Transferee.*

C. Holding Company (Transferee)

Infomovil Television & Systems Corp. is a Florida corporation operating from the State of Florida and is a holding company of the interests and business of the Applicants. The corporation is the Transferee of the individual interests of the Applicants (Transferee). The ownership of the Transferee is as follows:

- G. SANCHEZ, shareholder 33.34% of common voting stock.
- A. SANCHEZ, shareholder 33.34% of common voting stock.
- M.P. MERCED, shareholder 16.66% of common voting stock.
- MERCED, shareholder 16.66% of common voting stock.

III PUBLIC INTEREST CONSIDERATIONS:

The Applicants believe that this pro forma transfer will have no impact on competition, and its approval will continue to bring competition to the marketplace by benefiting consumers of international telecommunications services, most specifically those in the State of Florida and in territories where Identidad Advertising Development, LLC has traditionally provided services. This includes competitive pricing of services and increased availability of a variety of innovative service options. Therefore, this Pro Forma transfer furthers the public interest.

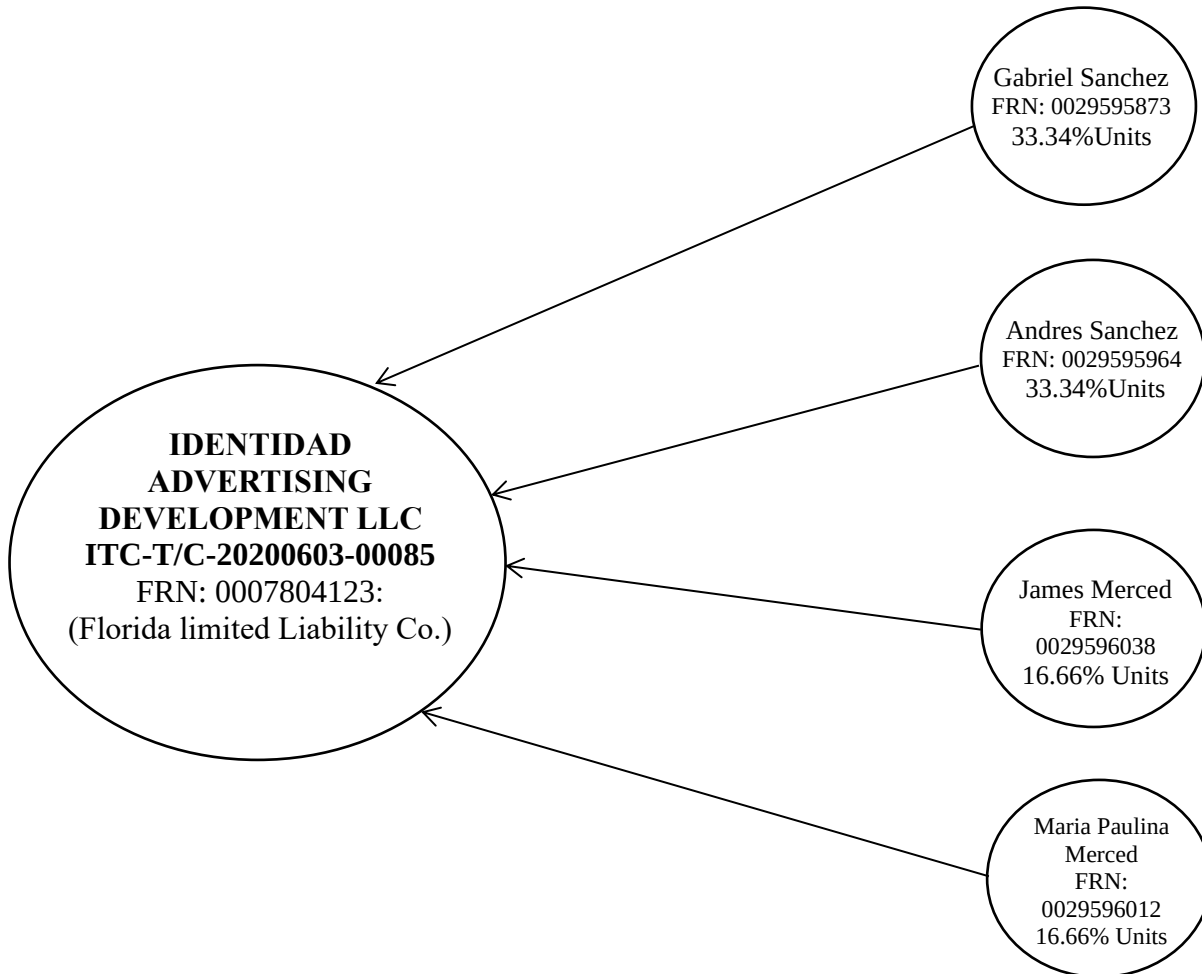

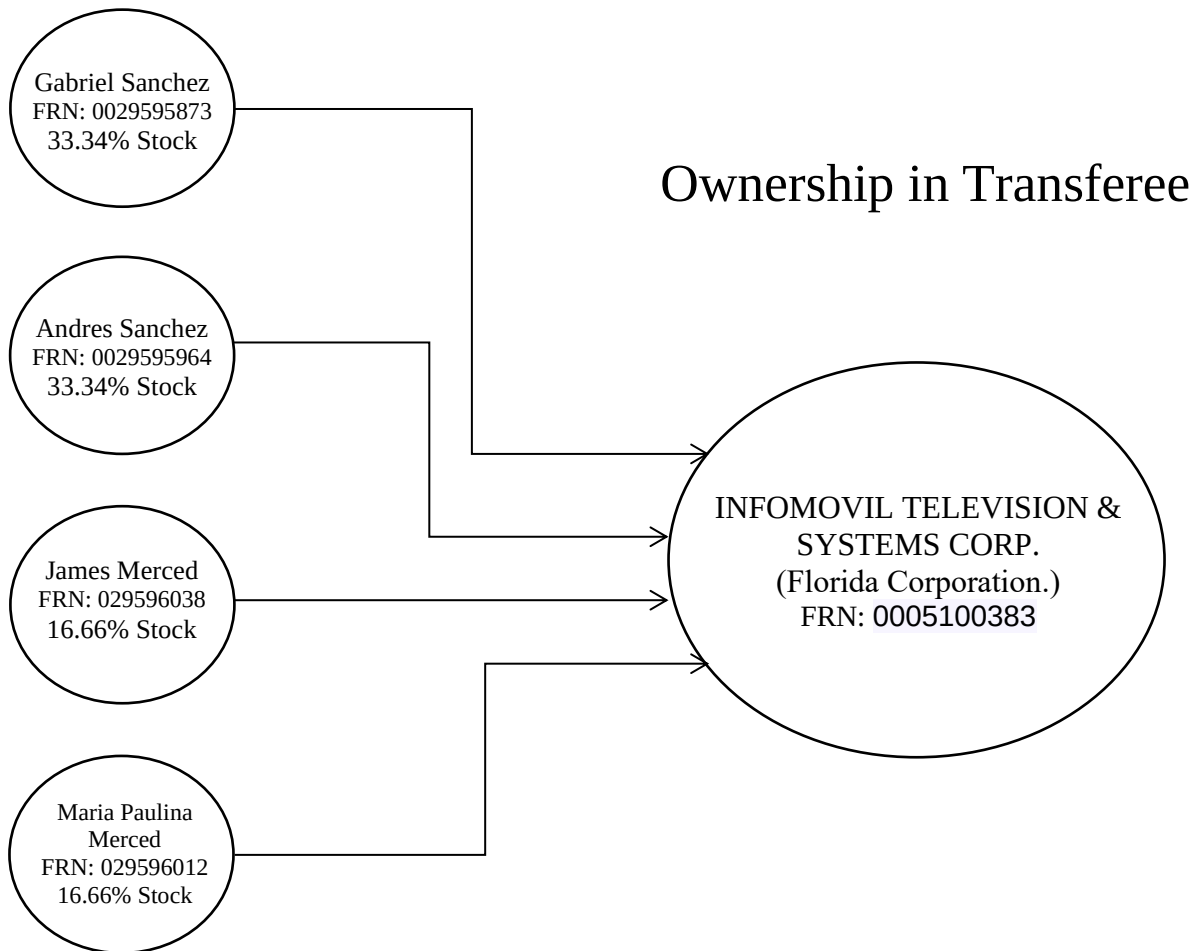

Pre-Transaction Structure Diagram Transferor Ownership



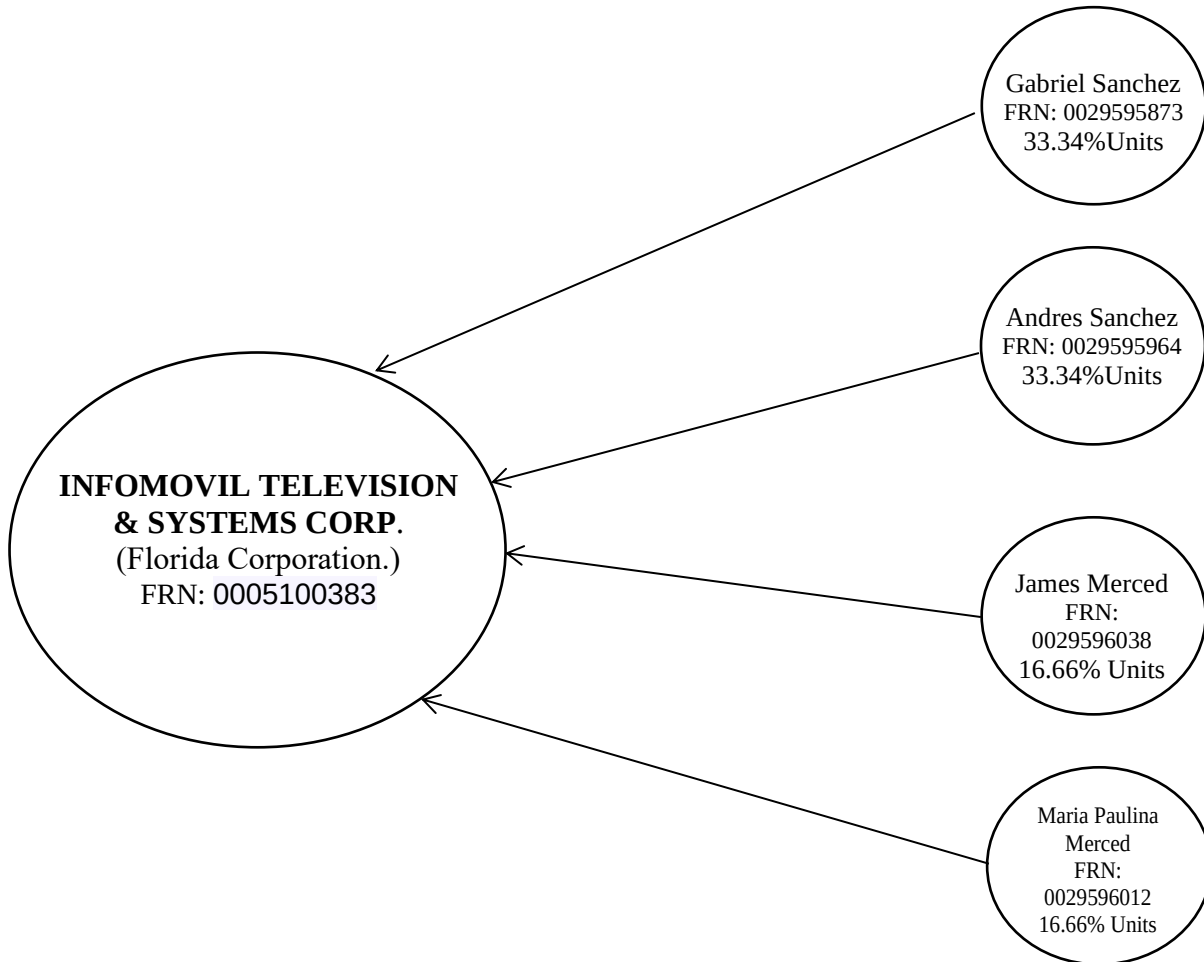
Pre-Pro Forma Transfer Structure Diagram
