

CHANGES IN INTEREST

Until January 1, 2022, TDS Broadband LLC (“Licensee”) was wholly owned by M.C.T. Communications, Inc., (“MCTC”), a New Hampshire corporation, which was wholly owned by Telephone and Data Systems, Inc. (“TDS”).¹

To effectuate a corporate reorganization effective January 1, 2022, TDS merged its wholly owned subsidiary, MCTC, into another of its wholly owned subsidiaries, TDS Telecommunications LLC (“TDS Telecom”), with TDS Telecom emerging as the surviving entity. TDS Telecom is a Delaware limited liability company.

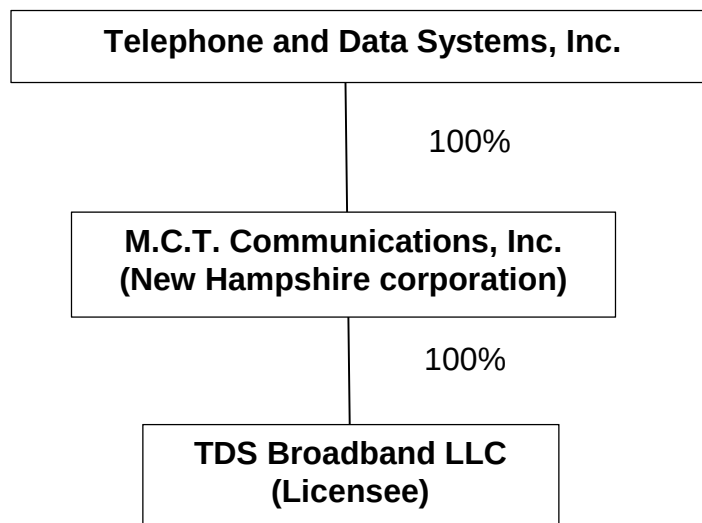
Because TDS was and remained in 100-percent indirect ownership of Licensee both before and after the transaction, the corporate reorganization was *pro forma*.² Accordingly, the relevant changes in ownership interests were very limited -- specifically, TDS Broadband is no longer wholly owned by MCTC but by TDS Telecom. Other than this one alteration, all other voting or ownership interests attributable to the Licensee remained unchanged as a result of the restructuring.
