Mr. Dyson died on December 31, 2014. With his death, Mr. Dyson's interest was transferred to his Estate. Mr. Dyson's wife, April D. Dyson, was the Executor of the Estate and remained so until the Estate was closed on September 29, 2020. On December 6, 2018, Mr. Dyson's ownership interest in Dycom was transferred to Mrs. Dyson. Mrs. Dyson now owns one hundred percent (100%) of the voting stock of Dycom.

**Explanation of Response to Questions 22 and 23**

Dycom and WLD provides the following explanation associated with the accompanying International Bureau Filing System (IBFS") form required for this Application.

With respect to Question 22, and as applicable here, a response is requested to the following query: "By signing this application, the undersigned certify . . . (2) that prior Commission consent is not required because the transaction is subject to the notification procedures for *pro forma* transactions under Section 63.24 of the rules." In addition, Question 23 in the IBFS form states: "If this filing is a notification of a *pro forma* assignment or transfer of control, the undersigned certify that the assignment or transfer of control was *pro forma* and that, together with all previous *pro forma* transactions, does not result in a change in the actual controlling party."

Section 63.24(g) requires that the notification of the involuntary transfer of control arising from a "death . . . to a person or entity legally qualified to succeed the deceased or disabled person under the laws of the place having jurisdiction over the estate involved" must be made by "the appropriate filing no later than 30 days after the event causing the involuntary . . . transfer of control." Due to the nature of this request, this notification was not made within thirty days of Mr. Dyson's death. Thus, Dycom responded to Questions 22 and 23 on the IBFS form with a "no."
