Application of L/Q Licensee, Inc.

L/Q Licensee, Inc., ("LQL") licensee of the Globalstar™ MSS Above 1 GHz system<sup>1</sup> and a wholly-owned subsidiary of Loral/QUALCOMM Partnership, L.P. ("LQP"), hereby requests, pursuant to Section 63.701 of the Commission's Rules, that Globalstar™ be designated a Recognized Private Operating Agency ("RPOA").

LQL is applying for RPOA status as part of its implementation of the Globalstar™ system. Once operational, the Globalstar™ system will make possible low-cost wireless voice, data and facsimile communications to nearly all parts of the globe. The Globalstar™ system will make possible the provision of these services to many areas that would otherwise remain unserved by wireless and wireline services.

This application precedes, but does not displace, any application for Section 214 authority which may be filed in the future. Although LQL is the licensee of the Globalstar™ system, LQL will not itself provide retail international telecommunications services in the United States over new or extended lines within the meaning of Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934 or Section

63.01 of the Commission's rules. Rather, LQL will construct, launch, operate and maintain the satellite constellation on a non-common carrier basis (see paragraph (f), below) while an authorized service provider - AirTouch Communications, in the United States - operates the national gateway earth station(s) and offers service to the public. As the January 1999 date for full commercial service draws closer, AirTouch will apply for such Section 214 authority as may be necessary.

In the meantime, however, Globalstar™ is currently participating on behalf of itself and its service providers in a variety of ITU and other international fora. Some of these fora require non-governmental entities to be authorized common carriers or to hold RPOA status. It is for this reason that LQL is filing the instant application at this time.

In accordance with Section 63.701 of the Commission's Rules, LQL submits the following information in support of its application:

- (a) The applicant's name is L/Q Licensee, Inc. Its address is 3200 Zanker Road, P.O. Box 640670, San Jose, CA 95164-0670.
- (b) LQL is organized under the laws of Delaware.

(d) Information regarding LQL's stock ownership is contained in the FCC Form 430 filed by LQL on February 12, 1996.

(e) A copy of LQL's Certificate of Incorporation was filed with the Commission on September 8, 1995. As indicated therein, LQL is a wholly-owned subsidiary of LQP. Fifty-one percent of the partnership interests in LQP are directly or indirectly owned by Loral Space & Communications Ltd., a Bermuda corporation.

(f) LQL will be a private carrier.<sup>2</sup> LQL will be an operator of radio facilities, licensed under Title III of the Act, capable of causing harmful interference with the radio transmissions of other countries.

(g) The services for which designation as an RPOA is sought will be extended to points outside the United States. LQL recognizes that provision of service from the United States to some of the countries listed in Appendix 1 may currently be prohibited by United States law or policy. LQL will comply with any such restrictions. The services for which LQL seeks designation as an RPOA are a matter of record before the Commission.<sup>3</sup>

(h) The facilities covered by this application will be used to provide private line voice, paging, data and fax services between points within the United States and points between the United States and the countries listed in Appendix 1 attached to this application.

(i) The services listed in paragraph (h) will be provided by facilities owned by Globalstar, L.P. LQP is the sole general partner of the managing general partner of Globalstar, L.P. Facilities owned by service providers authorized by Globalstar, L.P. to provide Globalstar™ service in various countries and territories will also be used.

LQL is aware that it is obligated under Article 44 of the International Telecommunication Convention to obey the mandatory provisions thereof, and all



regulations promulgated thereunder. LQL pledges that it will engage in no conduct or operations which contravene the Convention or regulations and that it will otherwise obey the Convention and regulations in all respects. LQL is aware that failure to comply will result in an order from the Federal Communications Commission to cease and desist from future violations of an ITU regulation and may result in revocation of its recognized private operating agency status by the United States Department of State.

Pursuant to Section 1.2002 of the Commission's Rules, neither the applicant nor any party to this application is subject to a denial of any federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 853(a).

WHEREFORE, LQL submits that grant of this request will serve the present and future public convenience and necessity. Accordingly, LQL respectfully requests that the Commission grant this request.
