Ford Motor Company's Electronics Division (ELD) previously submitted comments on May 14, 1990, concerning Orbital Communication Corporation's application for authority to construct a low-orbit mobile satellite system. ELD maintains its opinion that this system would provide service capabilities which could provide the automotive customer with the benefits of an additional element of vehicle security. ELD, therefore, would ask the Commission to consider favorably expediting the rulemaking and licensing process and to authorize construction without delay. Failure to act now would postpone and possibly jeopardize availability of the service.
