Dear Ms. Dortch:

Celsat America, Inc. ("Celsat") hereby surrenders its authorization to launch and operate the 2 GHz mobile satellite service ("MSS") system authorized by the Federal Communications Commission on July 17, 2001. Celsat has decided for business reasons no longer to pursue its 2 GHz MSS system.

Today, Celsat also withdrew its July 17, 2004 Application for Modification via the International Bureau's Filing System.<sup>2</sup> The surrender of Celsat's 2 GHz MSS authorization eliminates the need for Commission action on this related application.

Concerning Use of the 1990-2025/2165-2200 MHz and Associated Frequency Bands for a Mobile-Satellite System, Order and Authorization, 16 FCC Rcd 13712 (2001) (the "S-band License"). The Commission on August 2, 2001 modified the S-band license by authorizing Celsat to utilize Kaband feeder links. See In re Celsat America, Inc.; Modification of License to Authorize Geostationary-Satellite Orbit Mobile-Satellite Service Feeder Link Operations in the Ka-Band, Order and Authorization, 16 FCC Rcd 14278 (2001) (File Nos. SAT-AMD-19970925-00124, SAT-AMD-19980123-00009, SAT-AMD-20001103-00153) (the "Ka-band License"). Celsat also hereby surrenders its Ka-band License.
