Pursuant to Section 25.280(a) of the Commission's rules (47 C.F.R. § 25.280(a)), Intelsat License LLC hereby notifies the FCC of the commencement of inclined orbit operations for Intelsat 707, which is currently operating at 53° W.L. Set forth below is the information required by the Commission.

- (1) The operator's name is Intelsat License LLC.
- (2) The satellite left the 0.05° inclination control box on November 15, 2012. The last north/south station-keeping maneuver occurred on October 30, 2012.
- (3) The initial inclination (after the last north/south station-keeping maneuver) was 0.02086°.
- (4) The rate of change in inclination per year is as follows:

 $2012 - 0.812^{\circ}$  per year  $2013 - 0.787^{\circ}$  per year
