Space Station License for LM-RPS-1, Call Sign S2372

Dear Ms. Dortch:

By this letter, Lockheed Martin Corporation ("Lockheed Martin"), in accordance with the authorizations granted by the Commission, informs the Commission that Lockheed Martin's LM-RPS-1 radionavigation-satellite service satellite, Call Sign S2372, has been successfully launched and placed into operation at the 133° W.L. orbital location. Lockheed Martin confirms that the operations of the satellite fully conform to the terms and conditions of the underlying authorization. *See Lockheed Martin Corp.*, DA 05-1747 (Int'l. Bur., released June 23, 2005). Accordingly, the 15-year license term for the space station should begin today, with an expiration date of November 2, 2021.

A copy of this letter will be posted through the milestone module for Call Sign S2372. This action should result in the Commission's issuance of a public notice announcing that Lockheed Martin may now remove the remaining \$750,000 implementation bond for the LM-RPS-1 satellite, in accordance with Section 25.165(d) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.165(d).
