CONSENT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Mobile Satellite Ventures Subsidiary LLC ("MSV"), pursuant to Section 1.46 of the Commission's rules, hereby requests an extension until December 14, 2004 to file its response to the Comments of DIRECTV, Inc. and the Opposition of PanAmSat Corporation ("PanAmSat"), Intelsat LLC ("Intelsat"), and SES Americom, Inc. ("SES") in the above-captioned matter. 47 C.F.R. § 1.46.¹ All of these parties express concern with MSV's request to operate its proposed replacement satellite at 101°W with a 0.1° East-West station keeping box. 
their spacing concerns.² MSV has contacted counsel for all of the parties to this proceeding, and all have consented to this extension request.³


