Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 26, 2010, DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC (“DIRECTV”) submitted a copy of its satellite construction contract with Space Systems/Loral to demonstrate compliance with the contract execution milestone set forth in Section 25.164(a) of the Commission’s rules and its authorization to construct a satellite in the 17/24 GHz Broadcasting-Satellite Service to be located at the 110.9° W.L. orbital location.¹ On July 27, 2011, DIRECTV surrendered its space station authorization.² By this letter, DIRECTV hereby withdraws its due diligence showing and related request for ruling on compliance with the contract execution milestone.
