Re: Gamma Acquisition L.L.C. (Call Sign E060430) and New DBSD Satellite Services G.P. (Call Sign E070272), Orders of Proposed Modifications, WT Docket Nos. 12-70 and 04-356, ET Docket No. 10-152

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 20, 2012, Gamma Acquisition L.L.C. (“Gamma”) received an *Order of Proposed Modification* for its license for Call Sign E060430 and New DBSD Satellite Services G.P. (“DBSD”) received an *Order of Proposed Modification* for its license for Call Sign E070272. These proposed modifications were adopted as part of the Commission’s *AWS-4 Order*.¹ Gamma and DBSD hereby notify the Commission that they will not be protesting the proposed modifications. As a result, Gamma and DBSD request that the Commission promptly issue the AWS-4 licenses.

The *Order of Proposed Modification* also directed Gamma and DBSD to determine “how to effectuate the reconfiguration of the 2 GHz MSS band into an A-B/A-B arrangement,” with each licensee selecting a duplex pair.² Gamma selects the duplex pair of 2000-2010 MHz and 2180-2190 MHz. DBSD selects the duplex pair of 2010-2020 MHz and 2190-2200 MHz.
