On February 20 and 21, 2014, the undersigned, outside counsel for SES, discussed the above-referenced application for the SES-3 C- and Ku-band replacement satellite with Diane Cornell, Special Counsel to Chairman Wheeler. The SES-3 application has been designated as permit-but-disclose for purposes of the *ex parte* rules effective October 31, 2013.<sup>1</sup> I reiterated SES's arguments previously made on the record and discussed possible resolutions of the pending application and plans for handover of traffic from AMC-1 to SES-3, including potential interim measures to begin the transition.
