On December 6, 2017, The Boeing Company (“Boeing”) filed the above-referenced amendments to its applications for authority to launch and operate non-geostationary (“NGSO”), fixed-satellite service (“FSS”) systems in V-band and Ka-band. Through these amendments, Boeing requests to substitute SOM1101, LLC (“SOM1101”) as the party seeking grant of the NGSO FSS licenses from the Commission.

WorldVu Satellites Limited, d/b/a OneWeb (“OneWeb”), has an application pending in the same V-band processing round and has received approval to access the U.S. market in the Ka-band processing round. OneWeb requests to participate in any Commission proceedings regarding the above-referenced amendments and the proposed substitution of SOM1101 in Boeing’s place. Accordingly, OneWeb files this “written submission referencing and regarding such pending filing,” 47 C.F.R. § 1.1202(d)(1), in order to become a party to these proceedings for purposes of the Commission’s *ex parte* rules. No communications should be permitted in the
