

On July 31, 2018, The Boeing Company (“Boeing”), through its attorneys, filed a letter with your office indicating, *inter alia*, that Boeing may file an additional amendment to the above reference application to make certain changes to its proposal to launch and operate a non-geostationary satellite orbit (“NGSO”) fixed satellite service (“FSS”) system operating in the V-band, IBFS File Numbers SAT-LOA-20170301-00028, SAT-AMD-20170929-00137 and SAT-AMD-20180131-00013 (call sign S2993).
