## MOTION TO CONFORM OPPOSITION DEADLINES

TRW Inc. ("TRW"), by its attorneys, hereby moves to conform the deadlines established by Section 1.106 of the Commission's rules with respect to the petitions for reconsideration that were filed in response to the Commission's January 31, 1995 decision granting the above-captioned applications, TRW Inc., DA 95-130 (Int'l Bureau, released January 31, 1995) ("TRW"), by Motorola Satellite Communications, Inc. ("Motorola") and AMSC Subsidiary Corporation ("AMSC"). In their respective petitions, Motorola and AMSC both request limited clarification of aspects of the Bureau's order in TRW, and TRW intends to respond appropriately to each filer. AMSC's petition, however, was served on TRW by mail, and Motorola's petition showed hand-service, leading to a two-day difference in the due dates for TRW's opposition filings.

Under Sections 1.4 and 1.106(g) of the Commission's rules, TRW's opposition to Motorola's petition is due on March 13, while its opposition to AMSC's petition is not due until March 15. Inasmuch as TRW intends to address the related

assertions each filer has made in a consolidated opposition, and in order to avoid an unnecessary repetition of effort, it hereby respectfully requests the Bureau to allow TRW to file its opposition to Motorola's petition on March 15 (the deadline for oppositions to AMSC's petition). TRW asserts that Motorola will suffer no prejudice upon the grant of the modest extension requested in this motion; indeed, any reply Motorola would file will not be due until seven days after the last day for filing oppositions. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.106(h).

On the basis of the foregoing, TRW respectfully urges the Bureau to permit TRW to file its oppositions to Motorola's petition on the due date established under the rules for the opposition to AMSC's petition -- March 15, 1995.
