Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is written on behalf of Globalstar, L.P. ("GLP"), to inform the Commission that GLP has decided not to pursue processing of the above-referenced application. See Public Notice, DA 04-234 (released Jan. 29, 2004).

Specifically, GLP does not plan to use this application to pursue authorization for the specified 48.2-49.2 GHz and 37.5-38.5 GHz frequencies. GLP is also not pursuing use of the Telemetry and Command frequencies that were requested for use with the V-band satellite constellation.

The above-referenced application also requested authority to operate the proposed V-band satellites in conjunction with the 1610-1626.5/2483.5-2500 MHz band frequencies associated with the Above 1 GHz MSS service and the 1990-2025/2165-2200 MHz band frequencies, plus 1980-1990 MHz and 2160-2165 MHz where available, associated with the 2 GHz MSS service. These augmentations of the proposed V-band system also requested feeder link frequencies at 5150-5250 MHz and 15 GHz or 19 GHz for the uplink and 6875-7055 MHz and/or 6700-6875 MHz for the downlink.

GLP does not plan to use the above-referenced application to pursue space station authorizations using the Above 1 GHz MSS and 2 GHz MSS frequencies and associated feeder link frequencies. To the extent that these augmentation requests are deemed separate from the proposed V-band space station application, GLP is withdrawing these requests without prejudice to pursuing these frequencies in the context of other applications.
