

On August 18, 2005, the undersigned, Counsel to Globalstar LLC, and William F. Adler, Globalstar's Vice President-Legal & Regulatory Affairs met with Cassandra Thomas, Karl Kensinger, Andrea Kelly, William Bell and Stephen Spaeth of the Satellite Division of the Commission's International Bureau, and Neil Dellar of the Commission's Office of General Counsel. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the status of Globalstar's pending petition for reconsideration of the cancellation of its 2 GHz Mobile Satellite Service ("MSS") license, and to reiterate Globalstar's desire to construct and operate an MSS system in the 2 GHz frequency band.
