On August 2, 2001, Leo Mondale of @contact LLC (“@contact”), and Richard E. Wiley and Todd M. Stansbury of Wiley Rein & Fielding LLP met with Donald Abelson, Chief, Alyssa Roberts, Jennifer Gilson and Alexander Roytblat, all of the International Bureau of the Federal Communications Commission relating to @contact’s pending above-referenced application to launch and operate a non-geostationary satellite orbit (“NSGO”) global satellite system in the Ka-band.
