Pegasus needs two full CONUS slots

Two slots

- broadband service to ~1.2M customers
- local broadcast signals to 100 local markets
- affordable, in-orbit back-up
- \$45/month

One slot

- broadband service to only ~0.6M customers
- local broadcast signals to only 50 local markets
- in-orbit back-up is cost-prohibitive
- \$65/month
