Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 25.280(a) of the Commission's rules (47 C.F.R. § 25.280(a)), PanAmSat Licensee Corp. hereby notifies the FCC of the commencement of inclined orbit operations for Galaxy 10R, which currently is operating at 123.0° W.L. Set forth below is the information required by the Commission.

- (1) The operator's name is PanAmSat Licensee Corp.
- (2) The satellite is expected to leave the 0.05° inclination control box on April 22, 2008. The last north/south station-keeping maneuver occurred on March 12, 2008.
- (3) The initial inclination (after the last north/south station-keeping maneuver) was 0.0175°.
- (4) The rate of change in inclination per year is as follows:
2008 – 0.936° per year
2009 – 0.905° per year
- (5) The expected end-of-life of the satellite accounting for inclined orbit operation is September 2008.
