

Dear Ms. Dortch:

PanAmSat Licensee Corp. ("PanAmSat") hereby notifies the Commission that it has successfully de-orbited its Intelsat 6B satellite. The de-orbiting was completed on March 21, 2008. The final measured orbit of the Intelsat 6B satellite is 318 km above the geostationary arc, with an apogee and perigee of 390 km and 245 km above the arc, respectively. In the course of de-orbiting the satellite, PanAmSat depleted the propellant tanks, discharged the batteries, disconnected the power from the bus, and shut off the transmitters.
