Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Rainbow DBS Company LLC ("Rainbow DBS"), this letter serves to clarify the fee status for the above-referenced satellite space station applications. Currently, on the International Bureau Filing System ("IBFS") reports, the fee status is shown as "Filed – fee not required." There is a required fee for these applications and, as Rainbow DBS mentioned in its applications, it "will submit fee and Form 159 by hand delivery to Pittsburgh" as permitted by the Commission's rules.
