Dear Mr. Lin:

This letter refers to 115 License Subsidiary, LLC's (115 License Subsidiary) December 17, 2009 contract milestone filing for the above referenced 17/24 GHz Broadcasting-Satellite Service (BSS) space station authorization. Pursuant to its authorization and Section 25.164¹ of the Commission's rules, 115 License Subsidiary was required to enter into a binding non-contingent contract to construct its authorized space station by December 17, 2009. 115 License Subsidiary timely submitted a contract in support of its certification that it had met this milestone. To facilitate our review of the milestone submission and ensure that we have an accurate understanding of the mutual obligations created by the contract, please specify what payments have been paid under the contract as of the date of this letter by providing a cross reference to progress payments specified in Exhibit E to the contract or by providing the exact dollar amount paid under the contract. We recognize that 115 License Subsidiary has submitted a letter from Space Systems Loral dated April 7, 2010 stating that "all payments due under the contract" have been paid.

We also note that in the process of reviewing the milestone submission and comparing it with the technical parameters of the existing authorization, it appears that there have been small technical changes to the space station design. It is 115 License Subsidiary's responsibility to seek and obtain an appropriate modification to its authorization if the technical parameters of the space station are changed. Any approval by the Commission of 115 License Subsidiary's contract milestone would not constitute an approval of changes in the space station's design evidenced in the contract documents.
