Dear Ms. Dortch:

Intelsat North America LLC ("Intelsat") hereby clarifies that with respect to its above referenced application for the Intelsat 16 satellite:

- (a) The above referenced application seeks authority to operate Intelsat 16 at 58.1° W.L. in the following bands: 13750-14500 MHz and 11700-12200 MHz. Although the Intelsat 16 satellite also includes the bands 12750-13250 MHz and 10700-11450 MHz, Intelsat is not seeking authority to operate in these bands in the above referenced application.
- (b) The Intelsat 16 satellite at 58.1° W.L. will provide service in the bands 13750-14500 MHz and 11700-12200 MHz to Mexico, the Caribbean and Central America.
- (c) For purposes of the Commission's bond requirements, Intelsat 16 is not a replacement satellite for Intelsat 9, which currently operates at 58.0° W.L.
