Dear Mr. Stansbury:

This letter requests additional documentation in support of the above-referenced space station authorization for 95 License Subsidiary, LLC (95 License Sub). On August 30, 2011, the Satellite Division granted 95 License Sub authority to construct, launch, and operate a 17/24 GHz Broadcasting-Satellite Service space station at the 95.15° W.L. orbital location. The Division later authorized the transfer of control of the license from Pegasus Development DBS Corporation to Spectrum Five LLC.

On August 30, 2012, as counsel for 95 License Sub, you filed electronically in the International Bureau Filing System (IBFS) a non-redacted copy of the construction contract between 95 License Sub and Space Systems/Loral, Inc., together with a request for confidential treatment. The electronic filing did not include most of the exhibits to the contract. Specifically, Exhibit A (Statement of Work), Exhibit B (Satellite Performance Specification), Exhibit C (Mission Assurance Plan), Exhibit D (System Test Plan), Exhibit E-1 (Telemetry Tracking and Command and Ground Support Equipment Option Payment Plan and Termination Liability Schedule), and Exhibit F (Dynamic Satellite Simulator Requirements) were not filed in IBFS.

To assist the Commission in reviewing the contract, we request 95 License Sub to file each of the referenced exhibits to the construction contract. Please file the exhibits with the Secretary of the Commission no later than 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, with a courtesy copy to Mark Young of my staff. Failure to respond by this date may result in a determination that the contract does not meet the licensee's contract completion milestone.
