Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”), in accordance with the Federal Communications Commission’s (“Commission”) rules,<sup>1</sup> hereby notifies the Commission that the in-orbit testing of Intelsat 31 was completed on July 14, 2016 and that the satellite arrived on-station at its licensed orbital location of 95.05° W.L. on July 26, 2016. Intelsat also certifies that Intelsat 31’s operational performance is consistent with its license,<sup>2</sup> and that the satellite is capable of using all of its assigned frequencies.
