Skynet Satellite Corporation ("Skynet") previously filed an application for authority to launch and operate Telstar 12V,1 and on October 28, 2014, Skynet filed a milestone showing for Telstar 12V. Also on October 28, Skynet submitted to you a request for confidential treatment that was accompanied by certain materials Skynet had redacted from the publicly-filed version of its milestone showing.

The October 28 confidential package included a non-redacted copy of the contract for construction of Telstar 12V that was entered into between Telesat Luxembourg S.à r.l., a sister corporation of Skynet, and Astrium S.A., now known as Airbus Defence & Space.
