("Spire") hereby notifies the International Bureau ("Bureau") that NanoRacks, LLC ("NanoRacks") has informed Spire that NASA has completed its flight readiness review and approved NanoRacks' Cubesat Deployer for flight on the Orbital ATK OA-5 Cygnus mission.
