Power of Attorney

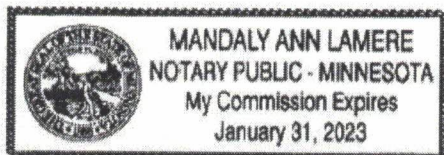
