Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Federal Communications Commission's rules, this letter provides notice that on September 25, 2019, representatives of Amazon.com Services, Inc.'s subsidiary Kuiper Systems LLC (collectively, "Amazon") met with staff of the International Bureau, Satellite Division ("Bureau") to discuss the above-referenced application for authorization to launch and operate a Ka-band non-geostationary satellite orbit system (the "Kuiper System").
