This letter confirms that, pursuant to Section 25.121 of the Federal Communications Commission's rules, the license term for Kuiper System LLC's Ka-band non-geostationary satellite orbit ("NGSO") system authorized by the Commission on July 29, 2020, is 15 years beginning at 3:00 am Eastern Time on the date Kuiper Systems LLC notifies the Commission that it has commenced operation of an initial space station in its authorized orbit and in compliance with all license terms and conditions.¹ Such notification must be made in accordance with Section 25.173(b) of the Commission's rules.²
