- 1. Silkwave must prepare the necessary information, as may be required, for submission to the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) to initiate and complete the advance publication, coordination, due diligence, and notification process of this space station, in accordance with the ITU Radio Regulations. Silkwave will be held responsible for all cost-recovery fees associated with ITU filings. No protection from interference caused by radio stations authorized by other administrations is guaranteed unless coordination and notification procedures are timely completed or, with respect to individual administrations, coordination agreements are successfully completed. Any radio station authorization for which coordination has not been completed may be subject to additional terms and conditions as required to effect coordination of the frequency assignments of other administrations. See 47 CFR § 25.111.
- 2. In connection with the provision of service in any particular country, Silkwave is obliged to comply with the applicable laws, regulations, rules, and licensing procedures of that country.
- 3. Silkwave must operate ASIASTAR at the 21.0° E.L. orbital location in compliance with all existing or future coordination agreements for this location. In the absence of a coordination agreement, such communications must comply with applicable provisions of the ITU Radio Regulations as the Commission cannot guarantee the success of the required coordination.

- 4. While at the 21.0° E.L. orbital location, Silkwave must maintain the AsiaStar space station with an east/west longitudinal station-keeping tolerance of  $\pm 0.05$  degrees.
- 5. Prior to commencing operations with the AsiaStar space station, Silkwave must file with the Commission the information required by section 25.172 of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR § 25.172, e.g., the 24/7 contact information for a satellite control center and a list of the call signs of any U.S. earth stations, and the locations of any non-U.S. earth stations, that are used or may be used for telemetry, tracking, and command communication with the AsiaStar. In addition to this information, Silkwave must file a current listing of the names, titles, addresses, email addresses and telephone numbers of the points of contact for resolution of interference problems and for emergency response.
- 6. The license term will end on December 31, 2026. Silkwave must abide by the commitments and undertakings set forth in the March 30, 2021, Letter of Agreement, between Silkwave and the U.S. Department of Justice.<sup>2</sup>

Licensee/grantee is afforded thirty (30) days from the date of release of this action to decline the grant as conditioned. Failure to respond within this period will constitute formal acceptance of the grant as conditioned.

This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release.

Station licenses are subject to the conditions specified in Section 309(h) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 309(h).
