On August 26, 2005, David Wilson, President of Spectrum Five LLC ("Spectrum Five") and Jennifer Hindin and Chin Yoo of Wiley Rein & Fielding LLP, Counsel for Spectrum Five, met with Emily Willeford, Advisor for International Issues, and Fred Campbell, Attorney Advisor, both of Chairman Martin's office. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss Spectrum Five's pending Petition for Declaratory Ruling to provide DBS service in the United States.¹ During the meeting, Spectrum Five described the Commission's procedures for processing market entry petitions for foreign-authorized satellite systems.
