Spectrum Five LLC (the "Applicant") filed a petition for declaratory ruling requesting authority to provide direct broadcast satellite ("DBS") service to the United States from Netherlands-licensed satellites located at 114.5° W.L. Section 1.1206(a)(3) of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission"), 47 C.F.R. §1.1206(a)(3), identifies a "declaratory ruling proceeding" as "permit-but-disclose" for the purposes of the agency's ex parte rules.
