On July 15, 2005, David Wilson, President of Spectrum Five LLC ("Spectrum Five"), met with Emily Willeford, Advisor for International Issues, and Fred Campbell, Attorney Advisor, both of Chairman Martin's office. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the pleadings filed in response to Spectrum Five's pending Petition for Declaratory Ruling to provide DBS service in the United States using a satellite system authorized by the Netherlands, and the issues raised by the commenters.¹ Spectrum Five also reiterated the importance of prompt Commission action on the Petition.
