Hughes Network Systems, LLC (“Hughes”), by its attorneys and pursuant to Section 25.152(a) of the Commission’s Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.152(a), hereby withdraws and requests the dismissal without prejudice of its Letter of Intent Submission under File No. SAT-LOI-20110809-00151 (Call Sign S2837) for a non-U.S.-licensed Ka-band fixed-satellite service space station to serve the United States from the 97.1° W.L. orbital location.

The withdrawal/request for dismissal of this LOI submission is effective immediately. Hughes emphasizes that only the above-referenced submission is encompassed by this request.
