I submit this letter on behalf of Spectrum Five LLC, regarding the two above-named satellite authorizations granted by the Commission last month.

Spectrum Five hereby declines the grant of two 17/24 GHz BSS satellite authorizations – Call Signs S2940, a 17/24 GHz satellite at 110.9° W.L., and S2941, a 17/24 GHz satellite at 115° W.L. The Commission has announced that later this month it will consider a Second Report and Order to streamline, eliminate, or update "numerous provisions of Part 25 of the Commission's rules governing licensing and operation of space stations and earth stations for the provision of satellite communications services." Spectrum Five declines these authorizations because the imminent rule changes have created substantial uncertainty. Spectrum Five reserves its rights to re-apply for authorization after the Commission adopts its rule changes.
