Dear Ms. Dortch:

ViaSat, Inc. ("ViaSat") responds to the notice of *ex parte* presentation of Telesat Canada ("Telesat") submitted in the above-referenced application proceeding on October 18, 2016. Telesat suggests that the grant of market access include a condition that it is "subject to the outcome of the international coordination process."¹ Telesat essentially repeats what is proposed throughout the record of this proceeding in its formal pleadings. ViaSat incorporates by reference its prior articulations why such a condition is inappropriate.

That said, ViaSat has no objection to a condition that is consistent with the recent precedent and that requires that ViaSat's operations "comply with all coordination agreements reached" between the United Kingdom and other administrations.² As ViaSat detailed in its prior submissions, there is no need for the Commission to deviate from recent precedent.
