On October 20, 2016, Greg Wyler, Kalpak Gude, and Michael Lindsay of WorldVu Satellites Limited, d/b/a OneWeb (“OneWeb”), together with legal counsel Brian Weimer of Sheppard Mullin and Jennifer Hindin of Wiley Rein LLP, met with Mindel de la Torre, Troy Tanner, Jose Albuquerque, Karl Kensinger and Jennifer Gilson of the Federal Communication Commission’s (“FCC” or “Commission”) International Bureau.

During the meeting, OneWeb provided the FCC with an update on its progress with system design, satellite manufacturing and user terminals. The meeting participants also discussed the significant public interest benefits of the OneWeb constellation in bringing broadband internet connectivity to unconnected schools and to households in remote areas, including Alaska. OneWeb also expressed its commitment to orbital safety and debris mitigation.
