The MVDDS 5G Coalition (the "Coalition")¹ submits this letter summarizing three separate meetings (all by telephone) as follows:

¹ The Coalition includes a cross-section of multichannel video distribution and data service ("MVDDS") and direct broadcast satellite ("DBS") licensees holding authorizations in the 12.2-12.7 GHz band, including: Braunston Spectrum LLC, Cass Cable TV, Inc., DISH Network L.L.C., GO LONG WIRELESS, LTD., MDS Operations, Inc., MVD Number 53 Partners, Satellite Receivers, Ltd., SOUTH.COM LLC, Story Communications, LLC, Vision Broadband, LLC, and WCS Communications, Inc. Members of the Coalition hold 212 of the 213 MVDDS licenses.

During the meetings, the Coalition representatives expressed support for the current draft *Order and Declaratory Ruling* in the above-captioned proceeding as it relates to MVDDS. As the Coalition noted previously, OneWeb's Petition, if granted, would severely restrict MVDDS in the 12.2-12.7 GHz band.² Consistent with this concern, the Coalition had asked that, in the event the Commission granted OneWeb's Petition, the grant be conditioned, among other things, on OneWeb's compliance with any MVDDS rule changes in the future.³

The draft *Order and Declaratory Ruling* strikes an appropriate balance among the needs of impacted stakeholders, particularly MVDDS license holders who hope to unleash the 12.2-12.7 GHz band for 5G uses in the future.⁴ We also agree with the Commission's position in the draft that "OneWeb's request includes several additional frequency bands, such that even if NGSO FSS systems were precluded entirely from the 12.2-12.7 GHz band, OneWeb would still retain a measure of flexibility to provide its proposed services." The Coalition thus supports adoption of the draft item in its current form as it relates to MVDDS.
